**2019 Islamic Days of Importance**

Twelve Islamic months are as follows: Muharram, Safar, Rabi-ul-Awwal, Rab-ul-Akhir, Jamadi-ul-Awwal, Jamadi-ul-Akhir, Rajab, Sha’aban, Ramadhan, Shawwal, Dhul Qadah, Dhul Hijjah.

The days listed below are dependent upon the sighting of the new moon for the Islamic month so an approximate date has been given.



3 April	27 Rajab	Night of Isra and Mi'raj
6 April - 20 April	1-15 Sha'ban	Voluntary fasting
20 April	15 Sha'ban	Night of forgiveness
6 May	1 <sup>st</sup> Ramadhan	First day of obligatory fasting
22 May	17 <sup>th</sup> Ramadhan	Battle of Badr
25 May	20 <sup>th</sup> Ramadhan	Conquest of Makkah
25 May – 4 June	20-30 <sup>th</sup> Ramadhan	I'tikaf
1 June	27 <sup>th</sup> Ramadhan	Revelation of the Qur'an begins
5 June	1 <sup>st</sup> Shawwal	Eid Al-Fitr
6 – 11 June	Shawwal	6 days of fasting
2 - 9 August	1-10 Dhul Hijjah	Blessed days for worship
9 - 13 August	8-12 Dhul Hijjah	Days of Hajj
10 August	9 Dhul Hijjah	Yawm Al-Arafat
11 August	10 Dhul Hijjah	Eid Al-Adha
1 September	1 Muharram	Hijri New Year
